## Initial Information about Planned Programme Meeting

• This is an *in-person* meeting of all 5 project teams of the UK/India-AMR programme (UK and Indian partners).

• This meeting is being hosted in our Mumbai partners at the Indian Institute of Technology, Bombay (IITB), India.

- Project teams will meet on the November 29<sup>th</sup>, November 30<sup>th</sup> & December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2023.
- Excursions in and around Mumbai are scheduled for December 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2023.

• A *hybrid* **Global Stakeholder Forum** will be held on December 4th & 5<sup>th</sup>, 2023. This will be led by the AMR-WATCH team.

• Project teams planning to attend the programme meeting are advised to budget:

o £1,500 per UK delegate (inclusive of flights, accommodation, and meeting attendance).

o R 50,000 per Indian delegate (inclusive of internal travel and meeting attendance).

• UK teams travelling to India are required to complete a course of travel vaccinations.

**Vaccinations should be completed at least 8 weeks before the trip**. Please refer to the <u>NHS</u> <u>fitfortravel</u> website for recommended vaccinations for travel to India.

• Visa applications can be completed <u>online</u>. Visa fees will depend on the visa type and duration of visa, and can cost approximately £210 for business visas of one year duration. Visa processing can range between three working days and three months depending on nationality of the visa applicant.

• Attendees requiring visas should start their application as soon as possible as there might be delays in securing visa appointments.

• The Indian Rupee is a *closed currency*, so Indian Rupees will only be exchangeable on arrival and departure from India.
